

ALASKA STAT. § 11.41.458. INDECENT EXPOSURE IN THE FIRST DEGREE

(a) An offender commits the crime of indecent exposure in the first degree if the offender violates AS 11.41.460(a), the offense occurs within the observation of a person under 16 years of age, and

(1) while committing the act constituting the offense, the offender knowingly masturbates; or

(2) the offender has been previously convicted under

(A) this section;

(B) AS 11.41.460(a); or

(C) a law or ordinance of this or another jurisdiction with elements similar to a crime listed under (A) or (B) of this paragraph.

(b) Indecent exposure in the first degree is a class C felony.

Alaska is a partial Public Law 280 state. Except for criminal jurisdiction on the Annette Islands, the Metlakatla Alaskan Native community may exercise jurisdiction over offenses committed by Indians in the same manner in which such jurisdiction may be exercised by Indian tribes in Indian country over which state jurisdiction has not been extended. In all other cases, Public Law 280 confers criminal jurisdiction to the State of Alaska.
